

PROPERTY POLICY

1—Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to clarify types of property and whom has liability for damage should an incident or accident occur.

2—Classes of Property

(1)

	DragonBoat SA (DBSA)	
	(a)	DBSA owns assets available for use by the Association in contract
		between Members and DBSA. DBSA makes this equipment available,
		charging a fee for use, and insuring against theft and vandalism.
	(b)	Members are expected to maintain this fleet under the Maintenance
		Charter.
	(c)	Damage caused through use or misuse of equipment by Members
		shall be covered by the offending member, either by repairs carried out by
		the Member, or by way of invoice to cover cost of repairs by a third party.
	(d)	All damage to DBSA property requires an incident report to be completed
		and emailed to the DBSA Secretary at the earliest convenience.
Powerblades Dragon Boat Racing Club SA (Powerblades)		
	(a)	Powerblades also own assets which are made available to club members
		for the purpose of participating in the sport. These assets may include
		paddles, personal flotation devices (PFDs), marquees and other
		equipment.

(b) Damage to this equipment must be reported to the club maintenance representative, Committee Member or other delegate.

(c) The club may choose to recover costs for the replacement or repair of equipment from the individual(s) causing the damage.

(3) Personal Equipment

- Powerblades accepts no responsibility for the accidental or intentional damage
 caused to property by the owner of that property, any Club members or spectators.
- (b) All personal equipment is the sole responsibility of the owner and is used by the owner at their own risk
- Powerblades, at the discretion of the Committee, may choose to repair or provide a suitable replacement in the event that such damage is deemed as an 'uneconomical repair.'
